- 5) **Read 1 Peter 4:8**
- 6) Why do you think that the 1st century Christians put such a huge emphasis on Biblical love? What happens when you truly love someone? Share a story about how you or someone you have known has dealt with difficult people or circumstances because of love.
- 7) **Read 1 Peter 4:9-10**
