Main Text: Colossians 3:1-3

Before You Begin: If people had to guess your priorities based on how you spend your money and time, what would they say your number one priority is?

Discussion Questions:

1. **Read Colossians 3:1-3**
2. What do you think it means to set your heart on things above?
3. What are the “earthly” things that are most likely to distract you?
4. Why do you think that there is such a draw to these things?
5. Do you think that it is “bad” to pursue earthly things?
6. **Read 1 Timothy 6:17.** What do you think it would mean for us to “enjoy” the things God has given us, rather than to “pursue” them?
7. If you had the ability to pass on to your children only ONE thing, what would it be?
8. How is this answer reflected in your priorities?
9. Jeremy referenced Nehemiah’s quote, “Behold, I’m doing a great work and cannot come down.” (Nehemiah 6:3). What will you have to say “NO” to so that you can intentionally and unapologetically prioritize God in your family?

Next Steps:

1. What are the things (material or activities) that you prioritize over things of God?
How can you reprioritize your life in order to show to your children (Grandchildren/ future children) that faith in God is the most important thing?
