Spider #1: God isn't Enough

Main Text: Hebrews 1:1-4

Additional Texts: John 14:6-9; Colossians 1:15-17; John 3:16; Romans 8:31-39; Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23

Before You Begin: What was the first type of music media you ever purchased with your own money? Do you remember which artist it was?

Discussion Questions:

1. The lie we are discussing today is actually a series of related lies. In short the lie is: “God is not enough,” but the lie can take various forms such as, “God is holding out on me,” or “God won’t come through for me.” “God isn’t enough” can either be because he chooses to not be enough to meet your needs/solve your problem, or because he simply never had it in the first place. This in essence is the first lie told by Satan in the Garden of Eden.
2. **Read Genesis 3:1-4.** Have you ever felt that God was holding out on you? When was a time when he didn’t come through for you and you felt hurt or let down?
3. What makes Satan’s lie so believable?
4. Why is it so easy for us to believe the lie that “God isn’t enough,” or that “he’s holding out?”
5. **Read Hebrews 1:1-2.** Does it give you comfort that we serve a God that habitually communicate with us? Perhaps this is the reason why you have bought into the lie? Does it frustrate you that sometimes it’s difficult to hear God?
6. What do these 2 verses tell us about how God has communicated to us? How can we hear Jesus?
7. **Hebrews 1:3-4.**
8. Jesus is the exact representation of God’s being. What does this say about the God that would send Jesus to earth?
9. He sustains all things. What does this say to us about our lives? The earth and laws of physics?
10. He provided purification for our sins. **Read Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23.** Why is sin a big deal? What does Jesus providing purification for our sins tell us about his love and concern for our eternity?
11. He is in a position of power— TODAY. How can we glean comfort from knowing that God (who created all and sustains all) is concerned with our eternal salvation so much that he

came to earth (even though he was God) in order to provide purification for our sins, and today is sitting in a position of authority and power in heaven?

12. Has God held out on us? Has God proven how much he cares about you? Has God proven his immeasurable power?
13. **Read Romans 8:31-39. Read Philippians 4:13**
14. What steps do we need to take to battle the lie, "God isn't enough," with the truths presented in His word?
