Key Text: Acts 4:23-31

IceBreaker:

Describe a time you were separated from a loved one briefly, then reunited. How did you feel? How did you act?

Discussion Questions:

1. If this homegroup were to read your prayers you prayed this last week, what would they be focused on?
2. Talk about a time when you didn't pray for your own safety when you probably should have.
3. If boldness is a quality we should have as followers of Jesus, how often do you pray for boldness? In what everyday situations, do you need boldness?
4. How can shifting your prayers from being externally-focused to eternally-focused take your prayer life to the next level? How can this homegroup help?

Next Steps:

In the selected text, we see the first prayer recorded by Luke that the first followers of Jesus prayed. They begin by declaring who God is and what He has done, then transition to ask God for help. They focus their prayer on continuing to do what Jesus instructed them to do before He ascended into Heaven: "to make disciples"; not focusing on their current problems or situation of being threatened. They make a collective decision to focus eternally, not externally. May we do the same in our lives and in our world.
