Key Text: Matthew 9:35-38

IceBreaker: What's your favorite school mascot? Why?

Discussion Questions:

4. Is getting to Jesus exhausting? Has the church made getting to Jesus exhaustful? Explain.
5. Read verse 38. Who do you think Jesus wants the disciples to pray for?
