### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Have you ever thought of God's grace like a "get out of jail free" card? As a follower of Christ, have you ever lived like the Gospel message hasn't transformed you? Explain.
2. Jeremy made the statement, "A good story changes the main character; whereas, a great story changes everyone." What story comes to mind when thinking of each? And is there another element to a story that evolves it from good to great?
3. How is the story you're writing changing you?
4. How does sin complicate your life? What boundaries are in your life?
5. What steps can you begin to take and turn your story from good to great? What behavior are you holding onto? What habit should you kick? Or start?
