2. What's the best part of parenting? What's the most difficult aspect of parenting?
*If you don't have kids, try to answer as if speaking for your parents or other parents.
3. Do you find it difficult to tell and to teach your child(ren) about God? Explain.
4. Read Proverbs 22:6. How can we and the church partner together better to help a child start off on the way he/she should go?
5. How does your story impact the next generation? How are you intentionally leading your children into a better story? How can you help a child write a better story?
