DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When have you used the following phrase: "I'm over it!". And what were you referring to?

2. What will life after this quarantine look like? Do you believe people's habits will change? Will their behavior be modified?
3. Quick challenge: can you recite all Ten Commandments?
4. Jeremy quoted the reformist Martin Luther in saying that idolatry is not simply a sin but the sin. Think about that statement, then share your thoughts.
5. Kyle Idleman lists seven questions aimed to diagnose a reader's false gods in his book, "Gods of War". Read these questions and consider them a resource to discover a false god in your life.
 - What has left you feeling the most disappointed?
 - What do you complain about?
 - Where do you make your financial decisions?
 - What worries you?
 - Where is your sanctuary?
 - What infuriates you?
 - What are your dreams?
6. After reading Exodus 20:5, have you ever considered that God will put Himself in opposition of your god. Have you ever experienced this?
7. What god(s) needs to be dethroned in my life? And how can this homegroup help you?
