BIBLE TEXT: Genesis 6:5-22

ICEBREAKER: What is your favorite card game?



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have you ever gone all in when playing poker? Or perhaps have you ever seen someone go all in while playing poker? Why is "going all in" such a big deal and draws such emotion when either playing or watching?
2. Before today's message, what did you believe it looked like going all in with Jesus?
3. What do you think was the hardest part about Noah and his quest to build the ark?
4. What's the scariest part of "going all in" at times in life?
5. Jeremy asked this question from stage, "Do you think Noah's life became more simple or complicated after deciding to follow God's commands?" After answering, consider this: Do we see this concept being accepted in our world today? In the United States today?
6. Read Genesis 6:22. At the end of your life, at your funeral service, will people be able to say this about you: "that [insert your name] did everything that God had commanded him/her."
7. What is keeping you from going all in? What would it take for you to all in?
8. Follow up question: What can this homegroup do to help anyone who has yet to go all in?
