OPENING QUESTIONS FOR GROUP:

1. How do you usually respond when it is your birthday?
2. Name a place you'd love to be sent to and a place you'd never want to be sent to. Why?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR GROUP:

3. Do your prayers revolve more around what God can do for you or what you can do for God? Give the group an example of how you'd like to pray from this moment forward.
4. What kind of every day awareness usually leads you to action?
5. Talk about the last time you felt compelled to do something out of the norm. How did you respond? Could it have been God directly you?
6. Who do you most identify with in regards to your response to God's requests — Jonah/"I'm not going.", Moses/"Send someone else." or Isaiah/"Here I am."? Explain.
7. Rank the four dangerous prayers (Search me, Speak to me, Break my heart and I'm available). Which is the hardest for you? Which is the easiest?
8. How has this homegroup helped you take the next step in the way you pray? If it hasn't, what can we do to help take that next step?
