Opening Questions:

- Out of all the jobs on your resume, which was your least favorite? And why?
- What other professions have negative stereotypes about them?

Discussion Questions:

1. Luke states that Levi “left everything” to follow Jesus. Can you imagine doing this? When you think of your own faith & following of Jesus, what has it cost you?
2. Think about your friends & family members. Are the majority like you? Do you make it a habit to friend others who are different than you?
3. If Jesus showed up in your town today, where would He go? Where would He eat? Stay? Visit? — do you go to these places as His follower? Why or why not?

Next Steps & Prayer Requests:

- Be kind and compassionate to someone this week that is often ostracized and left out of things.
- When making a mistake or committing a sin this week, try to do more than apologize to God, but repent. Take the necessary steps to walk away from past mistakes, sins and short-comings.
