Week 2 — A Sinful Woman

Luke 7:36-48

Opening Questions:

- Have you ever had an awkward moment during a meal? Do tell.
- Better yet, has there ever been an awkward meal-time moment during this homegroup?

Discussion Questions:

1. Would you agree that something special happens when sharing a meal with a group of people? In your opinion, do you believe this helps or hurts homegroups — especially those who have never experience a homegroup?
2. Read Luke 7:40-43. Think of all the “stuff” that you have asked Jesus to forgive. How does that make you feel? Does your perspective change about yourself? How does your view on others change when thinking of God’s forgiveness?
3. Jeremy said that Jesus never worried about guilt by association; “If Jesus was concerned with guilt by association, He would have never left Heaven.”
 - Have you struggled with this “guilt by association” way of thinking?
 - How might your outlook on others change if this statement is true?

Next Steps & Prayer Requests:

- Jesus wanted the Pharisees in the home to see the woman, not the labels they and society had placed on her. This week, would you choose to see people for the humans they are and not the labels we as society place on them? They are, like you, made in the image of a holy God.
