Opening Questions:

Discussion Questions:

2. Share some tips on how you and your family can rest better this coming week.
3. If you grew up in church, can you recall any "church rules" from your childhood? How do those differ from rules you might enforce today towards your own children?
4. Religion often times causes us to focus on rules and not people. Can you think of a time when you allowed rules to supersede people around you?
5. Garrett suggested that we cannot get Christianity right if we are getting love wrong. How does this statement change your outlook on this upcoming week? What specific steps will you take to choose people over religious activity?

Next Steps & Prayer Requests:

- Jesus ate with the Pharisees, prostitutes, tax collectors and so much more. He redefined the word "welcome". While doing your regular spiritual disciplines (praying, reading scriptures, etc.) this week, keep in mind that our God that we pray to and read about is love.
