3. Do you know someone who has recently pushed back against Jesus, the church or Christianity in and of itself?
4. Read the words of Jesus in John 6:53–58. What did Jesus mean by this? How would you explain it? Wouldn't it be understandable if someone pushed back against this teaching of Jesus?
5. Consider the rest of the story in John 6:66–69. As Jeremy said it, "If not Jesus, then who will you go?" "If not Christianity, what will you turn to?" In your experience and friendships, where are people turning to if not Jesus and His church?
6. In seasons of doubt, worry and anxiety, where do you often turn to in your struggles?
