UP FOR DISCUSSION

1. Share your first memory of when you were introduced to the Bible.
2. How has your view of the Bible change over the years: from childhood, to perhaps teen times into young adulthood?
3. If you're a parent or guardian, how do you teach your children about the Bible?
4. What do you think of the phrase, "If the Bible says it, then that settles it."?
5. Jeremy shared that Christianity didn't start with a book; it started with an event. This event wasn't even suppose to be recorded. The story of Christianity and the Bible doesn't start with an "in the beginning" but "an empty tomb". Do these statements challenged what you believe to be the Bible?
6. Has someone you know left the faith, Christianity, the church etc. because of something in the Bible? How do you respond to someone's criticism or skepticism of the Bible?

NEXT STEPS & PRAYER REQUESTS

- Invite "that someone" to Crosswind over the next couple of weeks as we discuss all things Bible.
- Consider what parts of your faith are solely based upon "the Bible says so" or perhaps all of it is. Remember that Christianity is based solely upon the event of Jesus' resurrection.
