- 5. Sin can often be like rotten apples: that one bad apple can ruin the rest. Describe your personal view of sin.
- 6. Some followers of Jesus can be described as practical atheists, believing God exists but living like he doesn't. Is there an area of your life where you are living like God doesn't exist? Have you grown accustomed to a specific sin?
- 7. Jeremy emphasized, "You cannot separate God's love and forgiveness from his holiness and justice." Do you agree or disagree with this statement? How does this statement shift your thinking about God? What next step can you take in your faith?
