DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. In Mark 8:27-29, Jesus asks his disciples two questions. In your own words, answers His two questions: "Who do the people say I am?" and "Who do you say I am?"
3. In your opinion, why did Jesus ask about what people thought first and then what His disciples thought second?
4. What is the difference between knowing what others believe and deciding for yourself?
5. If Jesus really is who He says He is, then what is one area of your life you need to allow Him to be Lord and King over?
